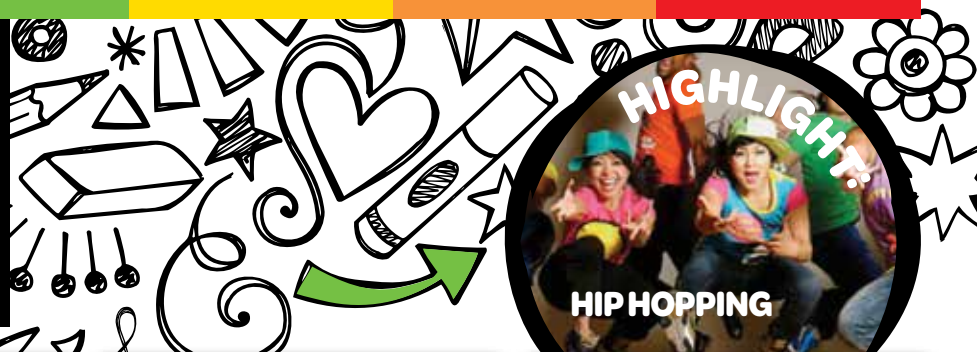

Excursion Information

Tuesday 23 April 2019: Wollongong Park Crawl

Today we are day tripping to the local parks of the Wollongong City with West Wollongong. We'll enjoy a hot chips at the Lighthouse and a play at some of the city's best parks. Bring your own morning and afternoon tea, lunch provided by centre. First we will collect Fun Club West Wollongong from their centre at West Wollongong PS.

The first park will be Stuart Park where the children will play on the fixed playground equipment provided for approximately 1 ½ hours. We will have morning tea together in a shaded area. We will then walk from Stuart Park to Wollongong Lighthouse.

We will have a short look around the Lighthouse hill, enjoying the views and playing some quick games for about ½ hour.

The park crawl will then move to Lang Park for approximately 2 hours. At Lang Park we will play large group ball games such as football and soccer, run, skip with ropes and create chalk drawings on the concrete. Hot chips will be provided for lunch which we will share in a shaded area at the park. We will then head back to the centre, dropping off Fun Club West Wollongong at their centre first before having afternoon tea when back at the centre.

Wednesday 17 April 2019: Nan Tien Temple

Relax and unwind on the beautiful grounds of the Nan Tien Temple. We'll learn how to meditate and do calligraphy at the Buddhist temple and lunch together at the temple. We will drive by bus to the Nan Tien Temple at Berkley. Bring your own morning and afternoon tea, lunch will be provided by the Temple. We will have morning tea before we leave the Fun Club or before we begin our tour of the Temple in a shaded spot outside. We will participate in a guided education experience as a whole group, touring the main Temple and grounds and taking part in two activities: meditation and calligraphy. The estimated time we will be at the Temple is about 4 hours. Lunch will be provided at the Temple's cafeteria in-between touring the Temple and our two activities. Once the tour is finished we will head back to Fun Club for afternoon tea.
