



Colour Scavenger Hunt

Experience

Invite your child to play colour scavenger hunt. Offer them a paper bag or container. Encourage your child to choose one or two colours. Explain the purpose of the game is to find items around the home that match the one or two colours chosen.

Encourage your child to explore with you in their surroundings e.g. inside your home or outside in the garden. When they have found an item that matches one of the colours, place it in the bag or container and keep exploring together. At the end of the game, explore all the items found and talk about them.

Learning benefits

- Increases visual discrimination, colour identification and colour order
- Builds problem solving skills
- Promotes sorting, classification and organising skills
