



Guess What?

Experience

Arrange a selection of objects on a tray and cover them with a tea towel until you are ready to start the game. Before starting the game, explain the rules.

Rules

When items are uncovered, allow 1-2 minutes for your child to view the items on the tray. After this time, cover the tray again with the tea towel. Allow your child 2 minutes to write down all the items they remember were on the tray. Uncover the tray and check to see what items they remembered.

Variation

Uncover and show items then remove tray, and take way one or two items and ask your child what is missing

Learning benefits

- Improves short-term memory
- Verbal communication
- Problem solving: forming a strategy to remember items

Materials

Tray
Tea towel
Selection of objects
Paper
Pencil

Hints and Tips

Vary the number of objects according to your child's age. Starting point is 1 item per age (6 yrs =6 items)
