



What's that sound?

Experience

Collect 5 items from around the house that will make some kind of noise. Sit with your child and look at the items. Talk about what the items are and explore what sounds they make. Explain the following rules of the game to your child.

Rules

Begin by asking your child to turn around. Then choose one item, shake it or tap it so it makes a sound. Ask the question "What does that sound like? Can you guess?" Give your child a little thinking time and encouragement before they give an answer. Guess all the items

Learning benefits

- Increases concentration/ attention span
- Develops auditory (listening) skills
- Develops ability to follow instructions

Materials

Kitchen items, recycled items, toys, things that rattle or shake, pouring water into a glass, things that beep

Hints and Tips

Repeat each sound before asking what it is

Acknowledge all guessing attempts
