



Plastic Bottle Quoits

Experience

Preparation: Invite your child to make this game. You will need to collect six similar sized bottles (all the same is ideal). Encourage your child to fill up the bottles half way with water (this helps stabilise them in the game). With the junk mail, ask them to roll it into a sausage shape, and stick both ends together with sticky tape (to form a ring). Cover the ring with foil to make six silver rings.

Rules: The aim of the game is to throw the rings so they go over the bottles. Each person takes turns in throwing the rings to see how many go over the bottles.

Variation: Label each bottle with one number (numbers 1-6). This encourages children to aim for certain bottles to collect more points when they toss the ring over a bottle.

Learning benefits

- Promotes turn taking in social setting
- Develops understanding of games with rules with others
- Promotes fine motor skills and eye-hand coordination
- Promotes number recognition
